핵심역량/전공능력	
수강대상	Students interested in International Relations, History and Politics. The course combines traditional, military-focused approaches to security with inter-disciplinary and critical security studies approaches, so there is something for everyone. The course uses some examples from the Asia-Pacific region, but there will be plenty of chances to look at the rest of the world as well.
수업목표 및 개요	Security is the single most important concept in International Relations, but the way we think about it has changed greatly over time. This course will look at the different facets of security as the concept (and the world) has evolved. We will begin with traditional military security, and what might be called strategic studies, and follow the evolution of the idea to include newer and increasingly important concepts such as human and environmental security. By the end of the course, students will have a well-rounded understanding of the concept of security, and will be able to use it as a tool to investigate all aspects of international relations.
선수과목(선수학습)	Some background in International Relations theory is useful but not necessary. This is not a theory course, but some of the concepts we use will be drawn from theory.
강좌운영방식	Weekly readings from the textbook, plus other readings as needed. Students will also be asked to research particular topics so that they can contribute to class discussions.
성적평가방법	Mid-term and Final essays: 30% each Class participation: 10% Security briefing: 30% Students will give presentations in small groups, choosing a particular country and giving an in-depth briefing on the security situation and concerns of that country. Each student will follow this up with an individual essay explaining how that think the country should conduct its security policy.
