Topic introduction in class

Every student will participate in one topic introduction during the course. In your topic introduction, you will either present **a chapter of a book from course literature or a journal article**. Below you'll find some requirements for, and assisting questions to help you draft, your presentation. Due to the high attendance, it is likely that you'll draft your presentation on your topic with other students. You can decide together how you'll study and present the material and share the workload. **All students are expected to show up in class for their presentation.**

Book chapters:

- Define and explain central topics in the chapter
 - 1-3 main points
 - The most important thing you learned
- How has the author engaged with the topic outside of the book? Can you find articles or essays by the author on the topic?
- What was hard to understand about the chapter? What concepts or ideas were confusing to you?
- Did you agree with the author? Did you disagree with them? On what and why?
- What would you like to ask the author?
- Conclusion: what is the takeout from this chapter?
- What other thoughts or sentiments did reading the chapter evoke?
- Come up with 1-2 questions about the chapter to discuss in class
- Duration: 20-25 minutes

Journal articles:

- What is the argument of the article? How is it presented?
- What is the research question? Does the article answer the research question?
- Introduce the methods and theories applied in the article. Why did the author use that method or that theory? How did they justify it?
- Define and explain central findings in the article
- How can you benefit from the article/the research in your future studies or your own research?
- What research topics can you come up with?
- What was hard to understand about the article? What concepts or ideas were confusing to

you?

- Did you agree with the author? Did you disagree with them? On what and why?
- What would you like to ask the author?
- What other thoughts or sentiments did reading the article evoke?
- Come up with 1-2 questions about the article to discuss in class
- Duration: 20-25 minutes
