It aims to further remaster basic functional grammar and develop language proficiency in Japanese, integrating four skills: speaking, listening, reading, and writing, in particular, strong emphasis is put on enhancing oral skills necessary for everyday life and communication. The course also involves a variety of oral practices and activities that focus on or include interaction with others in and out class. Ten 100minute classes a week.
