Course Objective

This course expands the knowledge you acquired in Literature in a Visual Culture 1 by adding to it theoretical insights into the relations between literary texts and visual culture as presented within the discourses on art, (inter)mediality studies, image(-/+)text studies, and comics studies. After completing this course, students will: 1) have deepened their knowledge of the relations between literary texts and visual culture, 2) be familiar with the theoretical frameworks that feed into the

specific topics of this course, 3) be able to apply one of more of these frameworks in the analysis of a specific case study, and 4) be able to report on their findings both orally and in writing.

Course Content

The starting point of this course is an exploration of several key texts in art, intermediality studies, and image, text discourse. During the following sessions, we will apply theoretical insights to found images/objects to examine how various theories can be illuminated or beg amendment.

Additional Information Teaching Methods

2 seminar meetings of 2 hours each per week.

Method of Assessment

20% participation and discussion posts

30% presentation

50% final exam

Both the final exam and the overall course score must be 5,5 or higher to pass the course.
