Course Content

Why are people religious, and how do we give meaning to life?

This course is an introduction to the psychology of religion. We will discuss the main approaches, theories, and concepts of the psychology of religion and their significance for studying lived religion and spirituality. This discussion will also involve the primary empirical research methods used

in the psychology of religion.
